



Terms and Conditions - *Fly'n For Fun* 2026

Our Expectations: Sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors are expected to present professional, high quality exhibits and to share in the promotion of *Fly'n For Fun* to ensure the best overall presentation of the fly in.

Acceptance and Allocation: *Fly'n For Fun*, Recreational Aviation Australia (RAAus) reserve the right to accept or reject any application for sponsorship, exhibitor, static display, or vendor package at its absolute and unfettered discretion with the return of any payment made. Packages which may be limited in number, will be generally allocated to those organisations who apply earliest. Allocation of the packages regardless of the preference indicated, is at the discretion of RAAus whose decision will be final.

Application and Payment: To apply for a sponsorship, exhibitor, static display, or vendor package please complete the relevant booking form provided to you by RAAus. On receipt of the form, a confirmation email will be sent with a tax invoice for the full amount payable shortly thereafter. If your payment is not received by the due date, the package will become available to other interested organisations. As opportunities are limited, returning a booking does not guarantee a place as a sponsor, exhibitor, static display, or vendor. You will be contacted by RAAus to confirm your acceptance.

Cancellation: Once a booking form has been received any cancellation must be advised in writing to RAAus. A full refund of the total price will be issued if the cancellation is received one month or more before the event. A 50% refund of the total price will be issued if the cancellation is received 3 weeks or less before the event. No refund will be issued if the cancellation is received within 1 week of the event. If the event is cancelled by RAAus, a full refund will be provided

Consequential Damage: RAAus will not be liable for any indirect or consequential damages arising out of a breach of the contract.

Detailed Requirements and Due Dates: RAAus requirements regarding the artwork for logos and advertisements, specifications for signage, arrangements for static display, other arrangements will be taken care of within the booking form or in communication to follow. Logos and display ads must be high resolution (300dpi) and are preferred in a .jpg, png, and .eps format. Should an alternative format be received, RAAus cannot be held responsible for the quality of the logos displayed in any of the promotional material. In the event that materials, information, or artwork required by RAAus are not received by the designated due date, their use for their intended purpose cannot be guaranteed. The value of these entitlements will not be refunded if this is the case.

Exceptional Circumstances: RAAus reserve the right to change the venue and duration if exceptional circumstances demand. In the event of a change of venue and/or duration, the agreement to participate will remain in force as long as the Sponsor is informed at least one month before the planned event. RAAus will use reasonable endeavours to remedy the impact of exceptional circumstances.



Responsibility: RAAus accepts no responsibility for any act, accidents, omissions on the part of service providers, the accuracy or content of any written or oral statements by speakers in connection with this event, delay, damage, personal injury, or death. Australian regulators require all Sponsors exhibiting at the event to have adequate Public and Product Liability Insurance cover based on a limit of indemnity to the value of \$20 million or above. Sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors present at the event are required to submit their Public Liability Insurance Certificate along with their booking form.

Sponsorship Packages: Please refer to the sponsorship packages in the initial application form for outlined benefits. Any variations to the description of each package must be as agreed in writing with RAAus. Sponsorship entitlements will not commence until the Booking Form and payment is received by RAAus.

Unavoidable Occurrences: In the event that the event is cancelled or delayed through no fault of RAAus, including but not limited to fire, flood, labour disputes, natural disasters, acts of God, civil disorders, work stoppages, slowdowns or disputes, or other similar events then the sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors shall not be entitled to any refund or claim for any loss or damage.

Event Venues: The sponsor, exhibitor, static display holder, or vendor and the staff, agents, contractors, and invitees of these companies are also to observe the rules, regulations and procedures as prescribed by the event venues.

Partnerships: Nothing contained in this agreement will be deemed to constitute a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between you and RAAus and you must not do anything where you will, in any way, represent that you are a partner of RAAus.

Health, Safety and Compliance Obligations: Sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors must comply with all workplace health and safety laws, aviation safety requirements, and event site rules. Food vendors must hold required licences and comply with food safety laws.

Permits, Licences and Regulatory Approvals: Sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors are responsible for obtaining and maintaining all permits, licences, and approvals required for their activities, including those for food service, sales, and the display or operation of aircraft or equipment.

Photography, Filming and Media Rights: By participating in the event, sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors grant RAAus permission to photograph, film, or record their participation and to use such material for promotional, marketing, and archival purposes.

Noise and Environmental Restrictions: Sponsors, exhibitors, static displays, and vendors must keep noise within limits set by the venue or local authorities and ensure their site is kept clean and free from hazards. All rubbish must be removed at the conclusion of the event.
